RULES

The rules of the NAYRU shall apply as modified by the Race Committee.

GOVERNMENT MARKS

Government marks that are not turning marks may be passed on either hand.

PROTESTS

Protests will be heard immediately after the race at the Skipper's Meeting. A protesting yacht must inform the helmsman of the infringing yacht as soon as possible of the intention to protest. A verbal statement to the Race Committee is required at the finish, identifying the parties to the protest. There will be no appeal from the decisions of the Race Committee.

COURSE MARKS

Courses will be posted on the Committee Boat with letters followed by a "Port" or "Starboard" designation for each mark.
